### **Important warnings**

- Use airco well® 996 hygienic cleaner for pollen filter boxes every time the pollen filter is replaced.
- Observe the manufacturer's instructions when installing and removing the components.
- No rinsing is required after cleaning with airco well® 996 Pollen Filter Box Hygienic Cleaner, not even with water.
- Before starting work, switch off the ignition, fans and air-conditioning unit.
- Carefully protect any electronic components in the cleaning area from moisture. Do not spray the cleaner directly onto the fan motor.
- If there are already any unpleasant odours or if any allergy symptoms have arisen, we recommend cleaning the evaporator in advance with airco well® 994 A/C System Hygienic Cleaner. We recommend cleaning the air-conditioning unit annually, even if there are no odours.

#### Attention!

- The following points must be observed when cleaning high-voltage vehicles (BEV and hybrid):
- Work on high-voltage vehicles may be carried out only by trained and authorised staff holding specialist certification (observe national regulations).
- Before starting work, high-voltage vehicles must be de-energised by staff authorised to do so and in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions
- There is a risk of serious injury and damage to the vehicle in the event of non-compliance with these points.

#### **Application**

- 1. Remove the pollen filter.
- 2. Spray a TUNAP microfibre cloth with airco well® 996 hygienic cleaner for pollen filter boxes.
- 3. Wipe out the pollen filter box and the surrounding air ducts with the damp TUNAP microfibre cloth.
- 4. Then remove the surface spray nozzle from the can, mount the mist probe and carefully spray into the hard-to-reach areas.
- 5. Allow the cleaner to flash off for approx. 10 minutes.
- 6. Insert the new pollen filter.
